RISK MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES	Normal Operation	⇒ Must have adequate adult/Leader supervision. No more Than Ratio 10 swimmers to 1 Supervisor, with a Minimum of 2 Supervisors. ⇒ All areas of swimming used is supervised. ⇒ Have a knowledge of hypothermic conditions ⇒ If person cannot touch the bottom, make sure person can swim. If they cannot swim have one on one supervision. ⇒ Inform people to use sun block on hot days	⇒ Maintain filtration unit ⇒ Clean pool regually ⇒ Treat and check pool water daily ⇒ Check what pool toys are available and whether or not they are suitable before campers enter pool area	⇒ Check pool before use ⇒ Assess weather conditions and cancel water related activities if necessary
